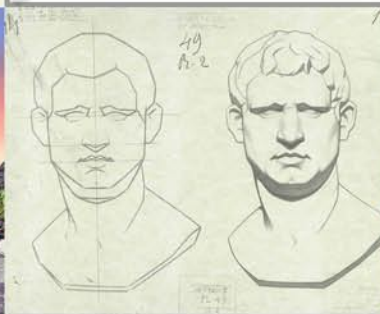

- How to use perspective forms, such as a sketchup massing model, as a basis for building a more detailed drawing.
- You will learn to use a photographic reference as a basis for a design drawing.
- How to use quick sketching as a method for exploring, developing, documenting and communicating your ideas .
- Learn to draw with a variety of media with greater confidence in front of colleagues and clients.
- How to use doodling as a key to building drawing skills and as a doorway to your imagination.
